Dear Parents and Students,

We are so excited about this year's Wild Adventure Camp. It's shaping up to be an awesome time of adventure and spiritual growth. The camp staff has been praying hard for a successful and safe camp. We put every ounce of energy and excitement into making camp great. This letter and following packet of information is designed to answer questions about camp, finalize your preparation for camp, and give you a snapshot of what camp will look like during the week. **There will be a student/parent meeting on June 19<sup>th</sup>, 5pm, at the First Baptist Church, Mount Shasta. We will be singing up for camp activities then. Please join us. *The last thing we need is an unprepared student or unprepared parents on the first day of camp.*** Here are some things we will need from you if we haven't already received them. We also wanted to make sure that we clearly stated our expectations and gave you the information needed about Drop-off and Pick-up. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from camp. We will have a sign-up sheet during the parent/student meeting for parents who would like to car-pool or arrange rides with other parents. **Students need to be dropped off at camp between 4pm and 5pm on Saturday, June 25<sup>th</sup>. NOT BEFORE! The staff needs adequate time to set up and prepare for the students' arrival. Students need to be picked up from camp between 11:30am and NOON on Wednesday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. NOT AFTER!** Also, there are extra costs involved for students who want to play paintball, airsoft, or go horseback riding. We will accept CASH only on site for these activities if not paid in advance. Horseback riding is \$35, Paintball and Airsoft are \$10 for players who bring their own equipment and \$20 for players who need to rent equipment. We hope this answers most, if not all, of your questions.

## THE GEAR LIST

### WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Bible
- Pen/Pencil
- Notebook
- Clothing for warm and cold weather, water sports, rafting, and other sports activities. NOTE: We reserve the right to have you change into more practical and appropriate clothing. For swimming and rafting activities, board shorts and non-white tank tops will be the most appropriate and practical.
- Jacket
- Sleeping bag/Pillow/Floor Mat
- Sunglasses
- Personal Hygiene and Toiletry Items
- Two Towels (one for showers, one for beach time)
- Hat
- Flashlight
- Sunscreen
- Mosquito Repellant
- Water shoes/Tennis Shoes
- Camping chair (optional)
- Camera (optional)
- Snacks permitted in your tent but beware of Squirrels

### WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP

- Electronic Games
- I-pods or other mp3 players
- Inappropriate books or magazines
- Alcohol, Tobacco, Drugs, or any prescription drugs not bearing your name.
- Guns, Knives, Hand Grenade, Bazookas, C4, Fireworks or other paraphernalia. If any of these items are found in your possession you will be sent home immediately.
- Bad attitude
- Cell Phones may only be used to contact Parents and you must get permission from your counselor.

All personal effects are subject to search and seizure by staff. If you have any questions about what is or is not appropriate just ask a counselor.

## Wild Adventure Camp Camper Expectations

1. It is expected that all campers be on time for all departures, meals, scheduled events, and tent group devotions.
2. Public displays of affection are not permitted. You're not here to "hook up" with someone; you're here to grow in your relationship with Jesus.
3. No camper is allowed to leave the property, other than for special events, without permission of the camp director.
4. Bathing suits and pajamas (what you wear to bed) are not to be worn around camp or outside of the swimming activities. NOTE: Pajama pants can be worn during hangout times in the evening.
5. Respect the environment. This means no cutting down trees, destroying young growth, littering, or defacing property.
6. Honor Scheduled lights out. Be in your tents at lights out.
7. Pick up after yourself. We are not your parents, and you are responsible for your personal items. Don't leave towels in the shower stalls, garbage at your tables, or personal things lying around camp.
8. You are expected to strive to be more like Jesus Christ in your attitudes, actions, and words.
9. Show respect for all staff, counselors, and fellow campers.
