

## **BRONCO BARREL GUIDELINES**

The Bronco Barrel is designed for all ages with adult supervision. One adult for every 4 participants is required for ages 8-12. The ratio for ages 13 and older is one adult for every 8 participants.

### **Safety Regulations**

1. Only one participant is allowed on the Bronco Barrel at a time.
2. 1 "Leg Puller" is required on each of the 3 cables of the Bronco Barrel.
3. 2 Spotters are required on each side of the barrel at the edge of the hay pad.
4. Long pants, shirt and shoes must be worn on the barrel.
5. Once the rider begins to fall off the barrel, the "leg pullers" must cease pulling cables.

### **Emergency Procedures For All Recreation Activities**

1. Provide immediate emergency attention and required care to person(s) in need from Adult staff on duty
2. Ensure notification of injury to qualified first-aid person for your camp and treatment of that injury.
3. Contact Camp Director and Ranch Management.
4. Practice follow up care of injured.

## **OTHER EMERGENCY PROCEDURES**

**HANDLING EMERGENCIES** - Obviously no two emergencies are the same. While the suggested actions outlined in these pages represent sound procedure, your own good judgment in light of a particular emergency should be the final authority. Please bring this guide with you for reference during camp. Be sure that at your staff is familiar with "Emergency Procedures" in case you are not available.

**FOR ALL CAMP STAFF:** Always err on the side of safety!

**EMERGENCY PHONE:** Is located in the white garage across the lawn from the office.

**SERIOUS ILLNESS / ACCIDENT** - If the accident appears serious **DO NOT MOVE VICTIM.** Seek medical attention from the nearest professional source. (Camp Nurse, Camp staff trained in First Aid or CPR), and Call 911.

**MEDICAL EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION** - Ensure that the Ranch Manager and Camp Director/Supervisor are notified immediately of transportation needs. Ranch Manager can contact either ambulance or airlift for emergency evacuation.

**☆ ACCIDENT FORMS - KEEPING THE RANCH MANAGEMENT INFORMED** - As the Camp Director please inform the office in any emergency. ☆Please fill out an accident report (located in infirmary) if any of your campers are seriously injured or transported to town for medical attention. If Ranch Manager cannot be reached, notify another ranch staff member.
